Fig.1. Analytical part for the territorial analysis

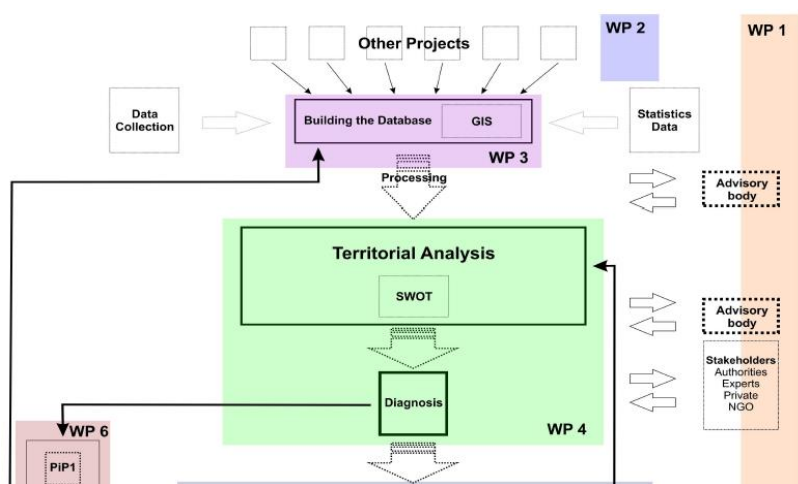

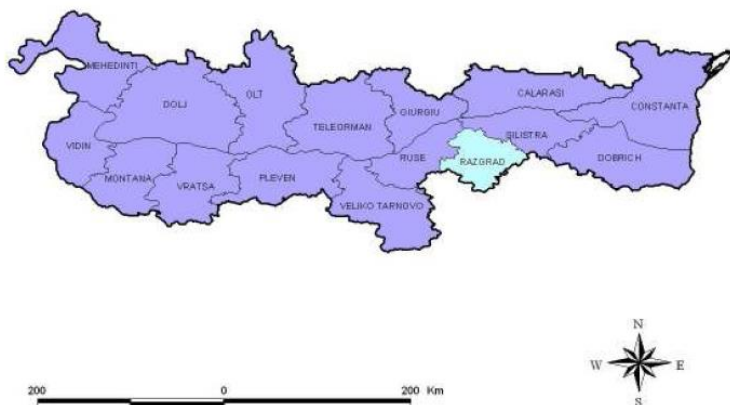
